Call For Papers

The CBE Brown Bag Series is a forum for faculty members in the College of Business and Economics and external speakers to present research in their respective areas. This forum is an opportunity for faculty to discuss their works-in-progress (scholarly, pedagogical or practitioner in nature, with potential for innovation or impact) and to receive feedback from colleagues.

The goal of the Brown Bag Series is to foster a vibrant and collaborative research environment by providing a space for interactive discussion as well as possible collaboration on scholarly work.

Submission Guidelines

- Faculty interested in presenting their research in the CBE Brown Bag series should submit an original and unpublished manuscript or a detailed abstract. Priority will be given to early submissions, submissions from junior faculty, and submissions from different disciplines.
- Faculty are encouraged to present papers that are in collaboration with their students.
- Each seminar will have 2 research presentations. If the number of submissions received exceeds presentation limit capacity, then faculty may be asked to present at a future seminar.
- Manuscripts or detailed abstracts must be submitted in Word or PDF format and might include the following (but not limited to):
 - significance of topic, issue, or problem
 - research design
 - conceptual framework
 - methodology and results

Submission Deadline: February 19th, 2024; 5:00 p.m. (PST) Where to Submit: <u>Upload here</u>. Notification of decision: By February 22nd, 2024

<u>Format</u>

Each presenter will be given 10-15 minutes. Each presentation will be followed by time for Q&A. Each sessions will include time for attending faculty to have an (informal) interactive discussion of their ongoing research and opportunities to collaborate. Light refreshments will be served.
